The first Methodist service at Mt Albert was held in 1866. Land was gifted and later that year the first church was built. New building, extensions and renovations have since taken place on the same site. The original church now forms part of the current church hall.

Regular services of worship are held on Sundays at 10:00 a.m. A Communion Service is held on Wednesday at 9a.m. Please join us. All are welcome.

Today, we are a gathered congregation with over 170 members plus adherents. We offer an active and growing Youth Group, Junior Church, study groups and opportunities for outreach,

Through a strong choir of up to 30 members, a musically talented congregation and guest soloists, Mt Albert offers opportunities for musical expression in both regular worship and special recitals and performances.

Craft is encouraged through a 30 plus member embroidery group open to both church members and the wider community.
