Children who are part of the Granger Grove programme attend St Mary's preschool which is also in the grounds of ATWC.

At St Mary's, children can explore and learn in a rich, stimulating and nurturing environment that their mothers are also encouraged to become involved in. Mothers and their children learn against a backdrop of positive encouragement and warm, reciprocal relationships.

Confidentiality

Confidentiality is maintained except when there is a risk to either the client or to others. This would be discussed with the client.


