- (4) Include information regarding Korean Methodist Churches in New Zealand on the Methodist Church of New Zealand website, and Year Book.
- (5) Officially invite the Bishop of Seoul-South Annual Conference to the Methodist Church of New Zealand Centennial Annual Conference in Wellington on November 2012
- (6) Provide annual orientation program about Methodist history in New Zealand, the ethos and regulations of the Methodist Church of New Zealand, and the diversity and current issues.
- (7) Determine the terms, conditions and processes for Ministers or congregations who wish to become part of the MCNZ, and provide the necessary education, consultation and agreements.
