Description: Research notes and copies of documents dating from 1830s-1980s for book *Samuel Ironside in New Zealand 1839-1858*, research for unpublished book "South Island Maori Mission since the Union of 1913", research for book *Winds of change*, information about Maori and Wesleyan missionaries and ministers, theological reference material.

Titles assigned by Rev Chambers are in quote marks in description. To house collection documents in ring binders have been dis-bound and may comprise more than one folder.
