In other words I hoped to make the opening chapters tell of what was happening in NZ (North) in what were to become (later) Whiteley's country. i.e. Hongi; George; Waikato's and Ngamotu (Taranaki, NP.)

Then - chapters on Whiteley England and his early years voyage to NZ, Bay of Island, \dots and so on...!
