INTRODUCTION

This index documents the items contained in the personal files of Rev William Thomas Blight, a minister within the Methodist Church of New Zealand for over 60 years. These files were donated to the Archives by his family in the early 1980's.

The files, which contain his sermon notes and other material he collected from a range of sources, are topical and arranged in alphabetical order. Some of these items are loose and not in actual manila folders. These have been included in this index.

The value of these files lies in his personal material that developed from a strong belief in scholarship and documentation. Such material will be useful in examining theological and social issues associated with his period of ministry.

This index lists the titles of the files in the order in the cabinet and includes only his personal material, unusual items (those that are on a different subject to the file) and items relevant to New Zealand.
